



# Trustee Update

As most can imagine, this year has been disastrous for our lodge financially. We've been shutdown for months at a time, have lost bookings for weddings & other parties along with River City Days, Holiday Stroll & Big Turn Music Festival. Our Trustees and other volunteers have stepped up to help get some projects done this year especially while our doors were closed. Following a close review of our finances year-to-date, the Trustees have asked Lottie to increase menu prices effective February 1st. We greatly appreciate everyone's support but found it necessary to make this adjustment to bring our food-related income inline with food-related expenses.

Thanks to the generosity of our members who have made donations to our roof repair fund & our Operations Fund along with volunteer time by our trustees & others AND some funding through HRA, we have been able to complete the repairs needed on our roof, upgrade our heat & air conditioning in the dining room and install a fire protection system required by the RW Fire Dept. In addition to help with operational expenses, we have applied for pandemic assistance through several grants that were open to non-profits like us who have experienced a dramatic impact on their financials due to COVID-19.

We certainly realize that not everyone is comfortable coming down to the lodge and being around other people yet. Lottie and our bartenders are working hard to make sure social distancing and mask guidelines are being followed. We greatly appreciate your support by not giving them a hard time if you're asked to put on a mask or not move a chair . . . We're trying to abide by the rules we need to follow to keep our doors open.

# Why is it important to pay my lodge dues by April 1?

April 1 is the official start of our new lodge year and the "magical" date when your annual dues should be paid by. Why?

By April 15th, we are required to pay the Grand Lodge AND the State Association for each member regardless of whether or not the member has paid their dues.

# What is included in the \$81.50 I pay for my dues?

\$ 5.00 Youth Camp Assessment

\$ 52.50 Stays in Red Wing to run our lodge

Life Members pay a little bit less each year for their membership. To be a Life Member, you must - be at least 65 years of age, a member for at least 30 years AND be approved by the lodge after submitting a written request to the Lodge Secretary. If you think you qualify, please contact the Secretary for more info.
