During the War of 1812, my great uncle, Francis Scott Key, observed the British bombardment of Fort McHenry in Maryland during the Battle of Baltimore in 1814 aboard HMS Tonnant where he was to negotiate the release of prisoners. Francis was inspired upon viewing the American Flag still waving above the fort at dawn, and wrote the poem "To Anacreon in Heaven" which later became what is now known to be "The Star Spangled Banner" after President Woodrow Wilson signed an executive order in 1916 and then President Herbert Hoover signed a congressional resolution that same year to make it officially the National Anthem of the United States of America. It's pretty awesome and patriotic to have that special piece of history in my own family's history.

The Minnesota Elks State Convention is approaching fast and our convention committee is working hard to make it a successful convention. We are looking for volunteers to help out with driving shuttles, bartending, greeting guests, and other duties. Signup sheets are located by the coat rack and I would encourage you to not only sign up for a shift but to enjoy the convention as an Elk. Join our lodge


