

American, the greatest country in the world! It is our freedom that makes it so and those freedoms were won & defended by our veterans!


For this we can thank the men and women who put the ideals of our country before themselves each and every day.



# Red Wing Elks Lodge #845 Proposed By-Law Changes March 2017

#### **Proposed Change #1**

#### ARTICLE V: ELECTIVE OFFICERS AND DUTIES

Section 4, paragraphs 1-7

WHERAS: The Bylaws now read: References to the Secretary as 'He' and 'His'.

AND WHEREAS: Section 4, Paragraph 6 now reads: 'For the faithful performance of his duties he shall receive as compensation \$3.850 per annum, payable monthly.'

(Change all references to now read)

(Increase compensation for the Secretary)

BE IT RESOLVED: The proposed new wording be revised to now read: 'He/She' and 'His/Her'
AND BE IT RESOLVED: The proposed new wording be revised to now read: 'For the faithful performance of his duties he/she shall receive as compensation \$4,200 per annum, payable monthly.'

#### **Proposed Change #2**

#### ARTICLE V: ELECTIVE OFFICERS AND DUTIES

Section 5, paragraph1:

WHEREAS: The Bylaws now read: References to the Treasurer now read as 'He' and 'His'. AND WHEREAS: Paragraph 1 now reads: '...for the faithful performance of his duties, and shall receive as compensation for his services the sum of \$2,750 per annum, payable monthly.'

(Change all references to now read 'He/She' and 'His/Her') (Increase compensation for the Treasurer)

BE IT RESOLVED: The proposed new wording be revised to now read: 'He/She' and 'His/Her' AND BE IT RESOLVED: The proposed new wording be revised to read: 'for the faithful performance of his/her duties, and shall receive as compensation for his/her services the sum of \$3,000 per annum, payable monthly.'

Read on the Lodge floor by Lona Bignell, Leading Knight on March 28, 2017
