

Soon, the kids will be headed back to school; we'll be closing up another season at the MN Elks Youth Camp and another summer will go into the memory books. As Fall approaches, our schedule at the lodge starts to fill up and there are so many fun events coming up in the next few months that will bring many guests to our community and hopefully, some are Elk members at other lodges and will stop in to see us.
